Over the life of <u>our 10-year Heritage 2033 strategy</u>, we aim to invest £3.6billion raised for good causes by National Lottery players to make a decisive difference for people, places and communities.

We offer funding for projects from £10,000 up to £10million (we may even consider investing above £10m for truly exceptional heritage projects).

All our decision making is centred around a simplified framework of four <u>investment principles</u>: saving heritage; protecting the environment; inclusion, access and participation; and organisational sustainability.
