The Co-op was an important part of many people's lives and was a well-loved institution. I've no doubt that people will come forward with their objects and memories so that the stories of the Co-op will be recorded for future generations to enjoy."

A special drop-in afternoon has been organised at Experience Barnsley on Friday 24 October from 2pm to 4pm for people to bring along their objects and find out more about this project.
