National Lottery Grants for Heritage

Project Title: Iron Age Round House

Applicant: Hermitage Parent Teacher Association

Project description: Build an Iron Age roundhouse in school grounds with the participation of school children and other local groups.

Decision: Reject

Project Title: In for a Penny - Black Britons in Business 200 Years Before Windrush

Applicant: Learn 2 Achieve Ltd.

Project description: Engage with young people from under-served ethnically diverse backgrounds to explore the lives of 3 Black Londoners from the past 200 years.

Decision: Award the request for a Grant of £80,951

Project Title: Heritage, Food and taboos: Myths and Gender inequality in Sub-Saharan cultures!

Applicant: Community Integration Project

Project description: Research and share rituals around food taboos in sub-Saharan communities. Support young people to begin conversations around the gender inequality some of these traditions foster.

Project description: Establish an Orchard Blossom Day supported by a new website aimed at the members of the UK Orchard Network.

Project description: To repair the Rose Room Window & Stonework in the Methodist Church, Ryde.

Project description: To celebrate the 500-year anniversary of the signing of the treaty of Waltham. This will promote local Tudor history to a wider audience through engagement activities, including a weekend event in the palace grounds.

Project description: To deliver an engagement programme and digital platform to run alongside the touring exhibition, 'The Legend of King Arthur: A Pre-Raphaelite Love Story' which would be installed at Falmouth Art Gallery.

Project description: Explore the industrial heritage on the Cox Lane Industrial Estate in Chessington, with a particular focus on the Gala Cosmetics business. Engaging with Kingston University and volunteers to produce a range of heritage outputs.

Project Title: Through the Lens: Women Pioneers, Youth Social Action and Celebrating our Somali Community

Project Title: The Fire Brigade Museum

Applicant: The Fire Brigade Museum Limited

Project description: A five-year project to establish a Fire Brigade Museum in Romsey, Hampshire, which tells the story of the UK Fire & Rescue Service, as well as preserving vehicles.

Project Title: Campaigning for accessible transport: Our history and our future

Applicant: Transport for All

Project description: Engage disabled people in creative arts and heritage activities to celebrate the applicant's 40th anniversary. Focussing on their past campaigns and progress made in achieving accessible transport for d/deaf and disabled people.

Decision: Award the request for a Grant of £126,970

Project Title: Cliftonville Voices

Applicant: Cliftonville Cultural Space

Project description: To explore the life of Margate Synagogue and the social history of the surrounding area. Activities will include recording the oral histories of 20 local people, historical research, an exhibition and online content.

Decision: Award the request for a Grant of £30,450

Project Title: Heritage nature trail and associated equipment

Applicant: Willsbridge Mill Community Refresh (CIC)

Project description: To create a history and nature trail for the Willsbridge Mill site, install wildlife cameras, and purchase bat detectors and other equipment to support species surveys and events.

Project Title: Voicing our Past

Project description: Using the voices of local young people to narrate and record/re-record the existing archive of histories, focussing on the childhood experiences of those living in Dover, Folkstone, Margate and Ramsgate during the Second World War.

Project Title: Complementary Programming- Silver Exhibition

Applicant: Portsmouth City Council

Project description: Deliver a programme of activities and events to support an upcoming exhibition showcasing the civic silver, which would be on public display for the first time since the collection began in the 1500s.
