National Lottery Heritage Grants £10,000 to £250,000

People | Passion | Priory: Brecon Cathedral, The Heart and Soul of Community

Applicant: The Dean and Chapter of Brecon Cathedral

Local Authority: Powys

Project description: The project seeks to secure the future of Grade I listed Brecon Cathedral by repairing the most damaged areas of its roofs, reorder internally to make broader use of the space, improve accessibility by creating a new entrance, install new interpretation and deliver a programme of activities with new audiences.

Decision: Award Grant Increase of £249,153 to make a total grant of £2,041,756; agree change in grant percentage from 49% to 54%

Bridging Worlds: Connecting Communities Through Gower's Heritage

Applicant: The Centre for African Entrepreneurship

Local Authority: Swansea

Project description: This is a proposed five-year project (February 2026 – Jan 2031) to collect, record and share the histories of two communities in Swansea and Gower: long-established residents and refugee and global majority communities that now call Swansea home.

The Welsh Christmas Caper

Applicant: RCT Learning Curves and Independent Living Service

Project description: This is a 5-month project aimed at creating opportunities for disabled people who are supported by RCT's Independent Living Service to explore the festive heritage of Wales and the traditions of pantomime in an accessible and inclusive way.

Decision: Award Grant of £10,800 (96%)
